Welcome to the 2018-2019 school year! We are so excited for the upcoming year and anticipate another great year for our students!

Last school year was a fantastic year for our school district! Not only did our students help to set the bar for academic achievement in the area, they dominated in the area of athletics. Our Comets not only won six Cascades Conference Championships and multiple district and regional championships, they also captured two State Championships. Yet again, we captured the Burdette Andrews All-Sport trophy which goes to the most successful program in our conference. To top the success our students had in competitions, we are even more proud of the multiple Academic All-State teams and individuals we had last year. Our students continue to do a great job of being all-around great performers!

As we move into a new school year, there will be several new faces throughout the district. We had two teachers retire in the spring, Mrs. Deda DeCapo and Mr. Lloyd Hilger. With the two retirements, we lost a combined 56 years of teaching experience. Our custodial staff saw the retirement of John Smith as our daytime custodian for the HS/MS building and Steve Brodock retired from our maintenance department. We are happy to have Mrs. Megan Thurston joining our staff to take Mrs. Twichell's 1st grade classroom. At this point, we are still working to fill the position that Mr. Hilger had. However, our plan is to replace the STEM class with the combination of Art/Fine Arts which we have had in the past. We have some great candidates to consider for that position as well. We also hired Mr. Joe Webb in our maintenance department and Mrs. Tami

Johnston will be joining our custodial team.

We also had to work to find a new elementary principal this summer. After 21 years with our district, 11 as the

principal, Mrs. Cindy Forgione decided that the timing was right for her to retire. She has done so much for the students and staff of our district over the years, that not only will she be missed, she will be very difficult to replace. As a district, we want to thank her for her service and wish her the absolute best in this next chapter in life.

School meals offer students milk, fruits and vegetables, proteins and grains, and they must meet strict limits on saturated fat and portion size. School lunches will meet additional standards requiring:

- Age-appropriate calorie limits
- Larger servings of vegetables and fruits (students must take at least one serving of produce)
- A wider variety of vegetables, including dark green and red/orange vegetables and legumes
- Fat-free or 1% milk (flavored milk must be fat-free)
- More whole grains
- And less sodium

We're always working to offer Hanover-Horton School students healthier and tastier choices. We are focusing on serving healthy homemade entrees, locally grown foods and increased offerings of whole grains.
