The 2019-2020 school year is upon us! We are so excited to welcome all of our new students and look forward to a great year!

With the support of our community, we were able to pass a new bond in May. While we had hoped that some of the projects could have been started this summer, it was just not feasible and would not have been costeffective. We are currently working with our architects to complete the design phase of our projects. After the plans are finished, we will need to wait for them to go through a review in Lansing before we can proceed. Most likely, everything will go out for bid during the winter and construction should begin in the spring.

This summer has been very challenging for many individuals, the community, and the District. As the investigation into one of our teachers continues, we appreciate your continued patience as it comes to an end. Depending on multiple variables, the investigation could be completed by mid-August. However, there were no time constraints placed on the investigator to allow her the freedom to run a thorough investigation. Once the process is finished and we receive the final report, details will be reviewed and the next steps will be decided. We will continue to share information with you as this process comes to a close.

We will have some new faces walking the hallways this year; a few teachers will be in new roles, and we have hired four teachers this summer. Last spring saw the retirement of Mrs. Marcia Shevy. Then, during the summer, Mrs. Jennifer French decided to pursue other opportunities. We will dearly miss both of them. Along with losing two familiar faces, we have added four new teachers and saw one teacher change buildings. Mrs. Kristi Swihart moved from 5th grade to the middle school and will be teaching math. Mrs. Kelli Arbuckle will be teaching a new 1st/2nd grade split classroom which was added to reduce class sizes for those grades. We are also excited to welcome our new teachers! Ms. Kayla Cotter will be teaching high school math, Mrs. Linzey (Yeaster) Cytlak will be teaching Young 5's, Mrs. Melissa

Bulgrien will be teaching 1st grade, and Ms. Emily Schock will be teaching 5th grade. We are so excited to see all of the great things these teachers will be able to bring to our district!

- A wider variety of vegetables, including dark green and red/orange vegetables and legumes
- Fat-free or 1% milk (flavored milk must be fat-free)
- More whole grains
- And less sodium
