Young 5s Supply List

Your child will need the following supplies for Young 5s:

- *colored pencils- box of 8

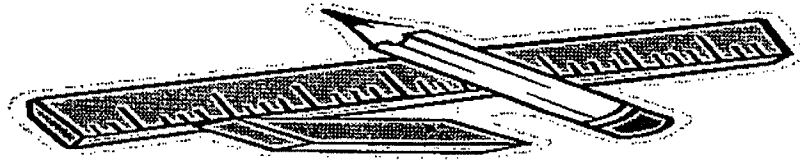
