COVID-19 Procedures

Students

- Complete the Student Daily Health Screening before leaving for school each day.
- If you are symptomatic or have likely been exposed to COVID-19, or have anyone in your home waiting for COVID-19 test results, DO NOT report to school. Have a parent/guardian contact the school.
- Wash hands often throughout the day.
- Face coverings are an individual choice, but are encouraged. Be respectful of the choices others make regarding face coverings.
- On any occasion that a student is riding the school bus, they must properly wear a facial covering which covers their nose and mouth.
- If you are sick, stay home.
- Several factors will be considered when determining student quarantines due to close contact with a Covid-positive person. Vaccination status and proper mask wearing will be major factors.

COVID-19 Procedures

Cleaning:

- High volume touch points and restrooms will be cleaned and/or sanitized a minimum of every four hours during the school day.
- Every classroom will be sanitized after each school day.

Transportation:

- In accordance with federal regulations, anyone riding the school bus must properly wear a face covering in accordance with the guidelines in place.

Face Covering:

- Under current regulations, everyone is encouraged to properly wear a face covering while indoors. At this time, we consider that to be a matter of personal choice. We expect everyone to be respectful to those around them.
- Along with vaccination status, proper mask wearing will be a significant factor in determining potential quarantines due to exposure.

Social Distancing:

- Effort will be made to provide as much space between students as practicable.
- Individuals may be quarantined due to close contacts occurring at school.

- Only enter a building if you are not sick, have not been recently exposed to COVID-19, or have anyone in your home waiting for COVID-19 test results..
- Please use sanitizer or wash hands prior to contacting any surfaces.
