

Schools of Choice for Out of County students Section 105c

A district may not refuse enrollment to a student eligible for special education programs and services, unless the application is under Section 105c and there is no written agreement with the district of residence. Special education programs and services are not considered "special programs" under Section 105 or 105c. If the student resides in a contiguous intermediate school district and is enrolled under Section 105c, the enrolling district and the district of residence must have a written agreement regarding the payment of added costs of special education programs and services.

Written agreements signed by both the resident and enrolling districts, and the resident and enrolling ISDs must be completed <u>PRIOR</u> to enrolling any schools of choice student who falls under Section 105c.
