FROM THE DESK OF SUPERINTENDENT JOHN DENNEY...

Welcome to the 2023-2024 school year! We cannot wait for our hallways full of students and staff to bring the buildings back to life. Thanks to our great maintenance and custodial staff, our facilities and grounds are in phenomenal condition and ready for another school year. We are so excited for the upcoming year and anticipate another great year for our students!

If you visit our buildings, you will notice the projects done this summer. All of our parking lots were chip-sealed and coated with an emulsion layer. This option was much more cost-effective than repaving the lots would have been and should give us several years before they need attention again. Our track is also receiving an upgrade this summer; the running layer was removed, a new layer of asphalt was added, and a new running surface is scheduled to be installed this month.

Thanks to the help and support of Alro Steel, Lomar Machine, and Optic Edge, we were able to add state championship "banners" to the east wall of the auxiliary gym. Our goal was to recognize our past championships in a way that anyone coming to our district would see. When our Comets win their next championship, the banners can be moved to easily accommodate the additional sign(s). The crew at Lomar took the raw material donated by Alro and donated their time/materials to create the signs. Optic Edge worked closely with Lomar on the design specs and handled the installation for us. This truly was a team effort. Without their expertise and generosity, we would not have been able to do this.

Our last project big project of the summer took advantage of a safety grant we received last year. A secure entry vestibule was added so that visitors to

my office will no longer enter into the school's hallway, but instead will enter directly into the office. The inside of the office was also renovat-

ed through the grant. Visitors will now need to walk up the sidewalk on the east side of the library to enter.

We are happy to introduce four new teachers to our community this year. Jake Spurgeon-Hess will teach middle school math. Micki Santoro will be teaching one of our Young 5s classes. We also have two new 5th-grade teachers: Kimberly Alley and Jessica Willis. Currently, the only vacancy is for a 2nd-grade teacher, and we will do our best to have that position filled before ABC Night.

This fall, our school board will be partnering with the Michigan Association of School Boards to go through a formal strategic planning process. During the planning, the input of stakeholders will be collected through in-person meetings and online surveys. The end result of the process will be a long-term plan to help guide the district. Please take advantage of this opportunity to help with this process. Information will be posted on our website as it becomes available.

As we move into another school year, I would like to again take the opportunity to thank you for the incredible amount of support you continue to give to the students and staff of our district! We would not be able to do all that we do without you!




and meet them prior to the school year. Teachers will have the opportunity to put out any last minute details, verify emails, phone numbers, communication procedures, and classroom rules and policies.


We'll have bus drivers to meet for your child's specific route, office and support staff, PTA, local community services, and youth athletics. We look forward to seeing you there!
