Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Hanover-Horton Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was identified as having not been given one of these labels.

The pandemic shutdown and reintegration of students to a social environment within schools created a learning loss for students and challenges to reduce the learning gap from those years. We use the data from our AER to assess our 5-year goals to decrease the number of students needing reading intervention, such as an IRIP (Individual Reading Improvement Plan) or scoring Urgent Intervention on the STAR Reading & STAR Early Literacy Assessment, by 10% by the end of 2024-2025. To support our students, HH Elementary implemented supports such as small group pull-out instruction with the Response to Intervention (RTI) program. For the 2024-25 school year, we have sustained a full staff of RTI Teachers and Aides. Students' math and reading data will be monitored and intervention time will be increased (as needed), after-school tutoring support has increased, Summer School for 2024 was held for student support, and Attendance Incentives. While looking at the whole child, we also recognize that social-emotional learning can help with

learning in the classroom. We have integrated a new PBIS program, a school-wide *Step Up for School Wellness*, and Character Strong for Social-Emotional Learning.

State law requires that we also report additional information:

1. Students are assigned to our school through district lines per state guidelines, and through school of choice applications.
2. The five-year School Improvement Plan from 2020-2021 to the end of 2023-2024 reduced our number of at-risk students by a total of 9%. Our school is on pace to exceed our goal for the academic year of 2024-2025.
3. A copy of the curriculum for the elementary and the state of Michigan standards can be accessed through the elementary website under [PARENTS](#) link for Curriculum Links. Each grade level has its own standards and implementation for each.
4. Hanover-Horton Elementary uses STAR Testing Data to determine trends and growths for achievement. The following is the information for 2nd – 5th Grade Data with 2nd Grade Early Reading, then 2nd through 5th Reading and 2nd through 5th Math testing scores compared students as they progress each year from grade to grade –

NOTE: This is the **STAR Early Literacy** Testing Data, given to K through 1st and some needing interventions in 2nd.
